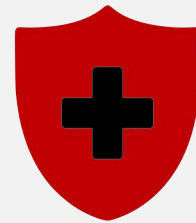
2024 represented a year marked by challenges, growth, and notable achievements for the PULSE team.

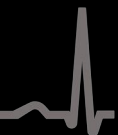
Military personnel received free training in 2024.

Spreading Knowledge: "Voices of TacMed" Project

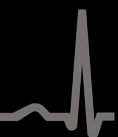
Together with Theatre on Podil and renowned public figures, we launched the "Voices of TacMed" media project.
